

ORDINANCE 2007-04

AN ORDINANCE SETTING WATER AND SEWER RATES, WHOLESAL WATER RATES, CONNECTION FEES, DISCONNECT AND RECONNECT CHARGES, METER DEPOSIT FEES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

SECTION 1:
WATER RATES

The following water rates will go into effect with meter reading dates as set forth below.

JANUARY 1, 2008

Perryville

Minimum bill	0-1000	gallons	\$15.65
	Over 1000	gallons	\$ 2.24 per thousand

JANUARY 1, 2008

Harris Brake

Minimum bill	0-1000	gallons	\$15.65
	Over 1000	gallons	\$ 2.24 per thousand

Current

Perryville

Minimum bill	0-1000	gallons	\$9.88
	Over 1000	gallons	\$2.17 per thousand

Current

Harris Brake

Minimum bill	0-1000	gallons	\$11.44
	Over 2000	gallons	\$ 2.17 per thousand

Each January 1 thereafter water rates will increase as shown below unless otherwise ordained by the city council.

Minimum bill	0-1000 gallons	2%
	Over 1000 gallons	3%

SECTION 2:
WHOLESAL WATER RATES

The current wholesale water rates are \$1.85 per thousand. With the implementation of this ordinance, and renewal of contracts, the wholesale rate will increased to \$2.35 per thousand.

SECTION 3:
SEWER RATES

January 1, 2008

Minimum bill	0-1000 gallons water used	\$5.84
Next	3000 gallons water used	\$1.33 per thousand
Over	4000 gallons water used	\$1.16 per thousand

Each January 1 thereafter all categories of sewer rates will increase by 3% unless otherwise ordained by the city council.

SECTION 4:

Water and sewer rates may be adjusted as set forth below for one occurrence per calendar year per customer because of a water leak. An adjustment of 25% will be allowed for loss over the customer's average bill for that month of the year. If we are unable to establish an average bill, five thousand gallons of water use will be used as average. No adjustment will be allowed for loss occurring after the customer was aware of a leak.

Sewer rates may be adjusted if water is used to water grass, trees or gardens. Adjustments for sewer will only be allowed for water used during the billing cycle for the months of July and August. Sewer rates will be adjusted based on the customer's average bill for that month of the year. If we are unable to establish an average bill, five thousand gallons of water use will be used as average.

SECTION 5:

All commercial buildings, residences, occupied buildings and all other customers using water will be on separate meters. No two occupied buildings will be allowed to be on the same meter except as follows. If approved by the city council, apartments, etc. may be on one meter but will pay a minimum bill for each individual apartment/user plus the water bill on the master meter.

SECTION 6:

Except in an emergency, reconnects will be made during regular business hours. For a same day reconnect, the request, payments, etc. must be completed thirty minutes before our regular workday quitting time. Any reconnect made outside our regular working hours will be considered an emergency reconnect.

SECTION 9:




SECTION 10:
