

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2007-05

AN ORDINANCE LIFTING A TEMPORARY SURCHARGE ON CERTAIN METERS AND SPECIFIED WHOLESALE AREAS EARLIER THAN THAT SCHEDULED BY ORDINANCE NUMBER 2006-02; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, extreme drought conditions necessitated the Perryville Water System to introduce a surcharge in order to recoup money from the expenses thereof.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the city of Perryville, Arkansas, as follows:

SECTION 1 - Surcharge

- (A) In as much as the basic rates for the customers of Perryville, Harris Brake and Thornburg will increase on January 1, 2008, there is no longer a need for the surcharge of three dollars and seventy-five cents (\$3.75) per month from those customers and will be terminated on December 31, 2007.
- (B) In as much as the wholesale water rates will increase for the Toad Suck Water Board on January 1, 2008, there is no longer a need for the per meter surcharge of three dollars and seventy-five cents (\$3.75) and will be terminated as of December 31, 2007.
- (C) Ordinance Number 2006-02 shall remain in full effect for all other wholesale purchasers whose rates are not being increased prior to the expiration of said Ordinance.


SECTION 2 - Emergency Declared

Because the City Council deems it appropriate to terminate this surcharge sooner to prevent a burden upon those affected, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication.


