

ORDINANCE 99-5

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF PERRYVILLE ARKANSAS

WHEREAS the city council of Perryville considers it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Perryville to establish a planning and zoning commission.

WHEREAS there is hereby created a commission to be known as "The Perryville Planning and Zoning Commission" and such will consist of up to seven members. There will not be an even number of members and not more than two shall hold any other municipal office or appointment.

WHEREAS the members of this commission shall be appointed by the mayor subject to confirmation by the city council. Initial appointment of commission members will be for staggered terms and as their terms expire, successor commissioners shall be appointed for three year terms. All members whose term expires shall serve until their successor has been appointed and confirmed. Any member may be re-appointed. All members shall be adult individuals and residents of the city of Perryville Arkansas.

WHEREAS this commission shall meet and designate a chairperson. Meeting times and places will be decided by the commission and will be open to the press and the public.

WHEREAS until changed by another ordinance, this commission will hold no authority except to report to and make recommendations to the city council.

This ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the city of Perryville shall be in full force and effect from its passage.
